FESTIVAL ASSISTANT:

Monday 28 September – Sunday 4 October

The lifeblood of the AWESOME Festival! Festival Assistants will perform a variety of tasks, with each shift bringing something new and exciting including:

- Answering questions from the public
- Manning exhibitions and installations
- Assisting artists with workshops and activities
- Distributing programs and other promotional materials

Festival Assistants must be **aged 15 or over**. Must be flexible, happy to work in a busy festival environment, and willing to positively engage with the general public.

TEAM LEADER:

Monday 21 September – Sunday 4 October

The Team Leader role would suit those who are looking for a little more festival experience, and are eager for extra responsibility. Perfect for those seeking hands-on event experience, our Team Leaders may perform the following tasks:

- Answering questions from the public
- Assisting on our Opening and VIP nights
- Assisting artists with workshops and coordinating activities
- Front of House duties including collecting door lists and directing patrons

Team Leaders must be aged **17 or over** and be available for **FOUR** full days at the festival. Must be responsible with a can-do attitude, flexible, happy to work in a fast-paced festival environment, and willing to positively engage with the public.

SCHOOL TOUR GUIDE:

Monday 21 September – Friday 25 September

Our School Tour Guides will direct a school or community group during the last week of Term 3 to a theatre performance, workshop and exhibition on the festival site. This role would suit someone studying education, as you will work closely with a group of school-aged students to foster creative thinking and engagement. Tasks on the day will include:

- Guide a school group through their excursion
- Assist students with artist run workshops and activities
- Inspire students to get the most out of the AWESOME Festival
- Work to a schedule and ensure groups arrive to their shows, etc. on time

School Tour Guides must be aged **17 or over**. Must be responsible with a can-do attitude, flexible, happy to work in a fast-paced festival environment, and willing to positively engage with students and teachers.
