#### A once in a lifetime experience!

Seashore is a performance for young children by young children. We are inviting children aged three years and younger, and their adults to participate as performers.

Join the team from Sally Chance Dance to create, rehearse and perform in Seashore at the AWESOME Festival!

We recommend that babies involved as project participants are at least 12 weeks old. We also require children to be not yet 4 years old in September 2022.

### What does the project involve?

#### WORKSHOP WEEK

The first stage of *Seashore* is a week of creative development workshops where you create and rehearse the content for the performance. These workshops run from Monday 19 September to Saturday 24 September daily at 10 - 11.30 am.

The workshops are child led, with you (The child's adult) taking an active part as their artistic partner, using play, movement, observation and connection.

#### PERFORMANCE SEASON

The second stage of *Seashore* is the performance season from Tuesday 27 September – Saturday 1 October with shows at 9.30am Tuesday 27– Friday 30 September and 9.30am and 11.30am Saturday 1 October.

You choose how many of the performances you and your child feel able to do. You will need to arrive 30 minutes before each performance.

### What will I be asked to do?

#### WORKSHOP WEEK

- Attend at least 4 workshop sessions or all 6 if you are able (we will help you catch up if you can't attend all of them)
- These workshops allow you to learn and rehearse the performance
- The workshops and rehearsals are all about you moving with your child

#### PERFORMANCE SEASON

- Choose the dates and times of the shows you can take part in (you are welcome to perform in all shows if you wish or just select a number)
- Perform with your child as one of the cast members in your selected shows
- Enjoy some special creative time with your child.



# Can I bring more than one child?

We encourage a 1 child, 1 parent ratio. However, please get in touch if you'd like to discuss.

### What do we have to wear?

- Wear loose comfortable clothes that allow you to move with freedom
- We ask that everyone takes their shoes and preferably also socks off
- Performance Season please wear your own clothes in shades of blue

### Will the project be COVID Safe?

- All staff and artists are vaccinated and will be taking routine RAT tests throughout the project
- We will practice distancing to the best of our ability
- We will make sure that all spaces, surfaces and amenities are deep cleaned
- We will provide hand sanitiser and wipes
- We encourage masks were possible
- Families experiencing sickness are encouraged to stay home
